The Bell Company has been awarded a design build assist mechanical contract by the Joint Venture Team of Tompkins-Turner, Grunley/Kinsley. This project is located on the Aberdeen Proving Grounds in Aberdeen Maryland. Aberdeen Proving Grounds is a 73,000 acre Army research and testing center for munitions and ordinance programs.

The occupant of the facility will be "Team C4SIR" which is the Army acronym for Command & Control, Intelligence, Sensors and Reconnaissance. C4ISR's primary mission is to advance technology, research and development in support of the Army's war fighter. C4ISR is also the Army's integrated facility that supports the war fighter in real time combat situations and is part of all Army missions thru out the world.

This project is a 9 building campus totaling 1,584,000 square feet. There are numerous electronic, technology and commuter laboratories located thru the facility. There will be 7,400 military and civilian personnel working on the campus. Because of world wide operations, many areas are designated as "24/7".

We are currently organizing our project staff in preparation of a March 2008 mobilization. Underground plumbing work is scheduled to start May/June with the first of the campus building's being occupied in July of 2010.
