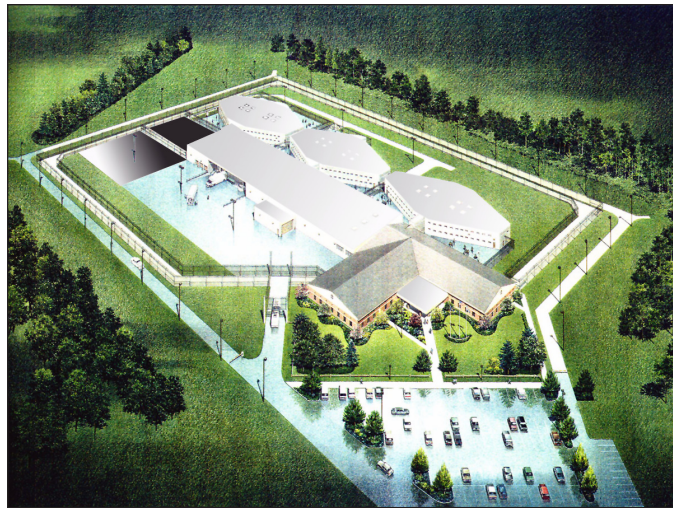


## INS Buffalo Detention Center

Batavia, New York



The Buffalo INS Federal Detention Center is an example of Bell's ability to exceed client expectations. Finished four months ahead of schedule, construction for this \$24.9 million facility earned Bell high marks for attention to quality, design intent, schedule and budget.

Situated on a 22.5-acre site, the complex consists of four free-standing buildings with small connecting links. Direct supervision housing units are divided into three housing pods--one containing cells, one containing dormitory housing, and one with both. The facility's comprehensive program includes:

- a low-security zone containing the executive office for immigration Review Court, INS Court Attorney's office, administration area and deportation office
- a primary secure zone, including security command and central control, as well as dormitory housing, single-cell housing, double-cell housing and medical housing beds.
- detainee recreation, laundry, food service, library facilities
- a secure area with restricted detainee movement, including health care facilities, service facilities, utility areas and staff training.

The design/build team worked closely with INS representative to develop the design for this facility, which features a harmonious blend of concrete, brick unit masonry and synthetic stucco that compliments the regional character.
