

Hemlock Lake Water Filtration Plant

Hemlock, New York



Bell was responsible for the general construction of this 35 MGD rapid filtration plant, which is the City of Rochester's primary water source.

The project included renovation of the existing raw water pumphouse, new filter building with laboratory area, two large settling ponds and six freeze/thaw ponds. Bell self-performed the site utilities, concrete (17,000 cubic yards), and all process piping.
