

## University of Rochester Schlegel Hall / Gleason Rochester, New York



Bell provided general construction services for this new 60,000-square-foot, four-story facility for the University of Rochester's Simon School.

The design for the classroom, lecture hall and office facility required significant attention to detail to match construction lines and marble and limestone finishes of the surrounding buildings on this distinguished campus. Consequently, Bell's workforce focus on quality and craftsmanship was a major contributor to the overall success of the project.

Interior construction required the same level of quality workmanship to achieve the design's fine interior detailing and impressive state-of-the-art lecture halls and classroom facilities.

From August 2000 to June 2002 Bell provided general construction services for the \$8MM Gleason Hall addition (38,000-square-foot) to the Schlegel Hall structure. Bell self-performed the sitework, concrete mechanical and electrical installations for this addition.
